Bringing firearms and ammunition into Sweden

** All non-nordic citizens must apply to the Swedish police to bring firearms and ammunition into Sweden. All ammunition you are bringing must be listed with the firearm you plan to use it for.*

**After getting your permit from the swedish police AND before you enter Sweden, you have to register your firearms and ammunition at THE SWEDISH CUSTOM's webpage.*

Make sure you know what firearms you are going to use during DOT 2024 **before you apply for an import license from the police. If you change your mind (or replace a broken gun) after you send your application -you will have to make a new application and pay the application fee again.*

We are making a guide on this process for you to follow, it will be published as soon as possible. Please be patient, there is still a lot of time to get it all sorted out.

Danish, Finnish and Norwegian shooters just have to register their firearms and ammunition on the web page of the Swedish customs. Please see:

Ammo Count MM, WB and all Side Matches and How to sign up:

No stages are designed yet, and there might be minor changes to the ammo count. The listings below are made to help you plan your trip. **At DOT 2024, all suspicious ammunition (too weak or too hard) will be tested in a cronograf.**

ALL SIDE MATCHES ARE TIMED AND SCORED WITH ONE TRY ONLY.

You have to make your personal ammo count depending how many side matches you would like to participate in. You may shoot all speed categories (even those you dont shoot in the main match) -except for Speed Wild Bunch which is for WB shooters only.

Upon completion of an RO II course, the student will be a SASS Certified Range Officer and have the knowledge of all aspects necessary to safely assist a shooter through a course of fire, provide necessary guidance and assistance in the event of an accident, and be able to enforce the rules and regulations in accordance with the SASS Shooter's Handbook.

Long Range with 6 shooting categories

Monday 13.00-18.00, Tuesday 09.00-17.30 and Wednesday 09.00-17.30

The shooting categories are: Lever Action Pistol Calibre, Lever Action Rifle Calibre, Single Shot, Buffalo Single Shot, Optical, Bolt Action (cut off date 11.11.1918). The Bolt Action category may be shot with full metal jacked bullets.

The steeltarget is 40x40cm and will be at a distance of 100 meters. All shooters gets maximum 3 test rounds + 5 rounds scored and timed. Scoring is by maximum number of hits with the shortest shooting time. Shooting position is shooters choice; Stand, kneel, sit or lie down, **No support** like sling, stick or pillow is allowed, except for juniors (14-16) and Buckaroos (11-13) whom may use a soft support for the rifle.

You have to make your own ammo count depending how many categories you shoot.

7 shooters are given the same slot to shoot (7 shooters take their positions at the same time), the 5 counting shots will be shot and timed individually.

A jury will judge all competitors in all Best Dressed categories. Each participant may enter each category only once. You can participate in categories that fit the gender listed in your pasport. In the remaining categories only shooters participants in the shooting competition at DOT can participate.

The Best Shooting Outfit and The Best Gun Cart will be judged by the jury on the range. All other best dressed categories must be entered in this form to be able to participate.

Couple: Consists of two people, minimum one of the participants must be registered as a shooter. Outfits that fit together or match in some way will be ranked higher.

Family: minimum one of the participants must be registered as a shooter. Minimum two people, must be related to each other.

Squad: minimum one of the participants must be registered as a shooter.

Three people or more. You may show up as a known/famous gang/group/posse from movie, tv, books or other. You should tell the jury about your Squad. The sign up for **this** category (this category only) will be open until the day before the judgement of Best Dressed (Wednesday).
